

UNIT: CHILDREN OF ISRAEL 9&10/10

Suggested Structure

Introduction - All Kids

Sunday School Assembly

(May include opening prayer, prayer requests, music, testimonies)

Encourage the senior students to lead the music, prayer and/or share what God is doing their life.

Summary of previous lesson – ask the children

Introduce lesson topic

Lesson - Break into class groups

Read through lesson content using discussion questions

(Read story or scripture from **children's bible*** or appropriate bible)

Discuss and breakdown as necessary

Craft/Activity

Finish

Summary of lesson

Cleanup, collate craft work, name and put in children's/class portfolio's or other

Supervised free play, outdoor games or board games if meeting isn't finished

Lesson Title

Children of Israel - Moses and the Children of Israel

Lesson Purpose and Themes


To learn about the Children of Israel, their history and purpose. Themes: Moses in Egypt and the Children of Israel leaving Egypt.

NOTE - This lesson will run for at least 2 sessions

UNIT: CHILDREN OF ISRAEL 9&10/10



Lesson Content

Over this Unit the children have been learning the history of the Children of Israel. Last lesson was a snap shot of Joseph's success in Egypt. Joseph knew he was called to Egypt by God to prepare a place for his family, his family being the descendants of Israel.

The time space between Genesis and Exodus, Genesis ending with Joseph and Exodus starting with Israel in slavery, is about 400 years.

The Children of Israel were a rapidly growing people. Many years after Joseph died the succeeding Pharaohs eventually forgot about the agreement he and his family had with the Egyptians and the great things Joseph did for the country. The Egyptians also became afraid of the Children of Israel because they were so successful and blessed and therefore they decided to rule over them and make them their slaves.

The 'Prince of Peace' Movie starts with the birth of Moses and carries onto Israel being freed from slavery and crossing the red sea.

Session 1

In a circle time ask the children what they remember from past lessons and how the children of Israel grew to be a large and blessed family.

If needed, play some active games before putting on the movie for 30-45 mins.

If time allows, bring the children back into a circle time and talk about what has happened so far after watching half of the movie.

Follow this with active games if time allows.

Session 2

In a circle time ask the children what they remember of the first half of the movie, where did they get up to, what happened, what they think about what happened and what they think will happen.

If needed, play some active games before playing the remainder of the movie.

Follow this with active games if time allows.
